VINO NOCETO



Among the pioneers who introduced Sangiovese to the New World, the Gullett family set out in 1985 with the singular goal of making Vino Noceto California's premiere Sangiovese producer. They are now renowned for making "California's Best Sangiovese." From just three producing acres and 110 cases in their inaugural 1990 vintage, they now farm over 25 acres and produce 10,000 cases per year, including ten different Sangioveses, a frizzante Moscato, an old vine Zinfandel, Barbera, Aglianico, and more.

VINEYARDS

100% Estate Trebbiano from vines planted on our Winery property in 1988 and 1994.

WINEMAKING

Pressed and fermented in new French oak barrels for 26 days. After primary fermentation, malolactic fermentation was completed. Weekly sur lie stirring prevented oxidation, enhanced creamy textures, and refined flavors.

THE WINE

Our estate-grown, sur lie-aged Trebbiano bursts with tangerine, dried apricot, white peach, and fresh herbs. Don't drink it too cold - this bottle opens up as it warms in your glass! Serve with white fish and light dishes featuring butter sauces, soft cheeses, citrus, or toasted nuts.
